Bri-Mor Developments launches West Grove Estates in city's southwest

A year after her husband died,
Fatima Dhanani went from
administrative assistant and
mother to president of a small but
growing residential developer that is

making a solid reputation.
A sharp learning curve to be sure.
"I had no clue about development,"
says the president of Bri-Mor Developments from outside the show home

parade at West Grove Estates, the company's latest residential venture.
"But I had to learn — and learn quickly, And I've come to find a sense of satisfaction and fulfilment in it."

in 1989, Haider Dhanani founded the company — whose name is derived from "bricks and mortar" — as a real

estate asset and management com-

estate asset and management com-pany specializing in commercial and multi-family buildings. In 1996, the company expanded into developing residential subdivisions and industrial, retail and office space.

Focusing its efforts on the trendy west side of Calgary, West Grove Estates is the followup community to Bri-Mor's initial residential foray in 2006 — Aspen Cliff Estates, a 53-lot up-scale community just outside the gates of Webber Academy at the west end of

14th Avenue past 93rd Street S.W. West Grove Estates is a 96-home upper-end enclave on eight hectares at 10th Avenue and 77th Street S.W. off Old Banff Coach just a few blocks east of Aspen Cliff.

ESTATE: Pathway

Four show homes, built by Crystal Creek Homes, Augusta Fine Homes, Lupi Luxury Homes, and Arcuri Homes, will be officially opened today at noon.
The first two phases —

which encompass six hectares containing 74 lots from 48- to 52-feet wide, are under construction with the first occupancy expected this month.

A third phase to the east

will be ready next summer, says company managing director Aleem Dhanani, Fa-tima's son.

With the closing of a porwith the closing of a por-tion of 10th Avenue, Bri-Mor will provide a pathway and other landscaping elements to further enhance the new

community.

Investing in amenities is important, both for Bri-Mor and its customers.

"We're investing in the details," says Aleem, adding that among the upgraded community amenities are lots of green space and areas for families, Tyndalstone entry features and no-maintenance fences, accented by ornamental fencing along the park space. In all, there will be nearly two hectares of

green space. And, adds Dhanani, Bri-

Mor has been successful on the city's west side, an area that has been popular with the move-up and estate markets.

"The west side is resilient and has been able to preserve its value through the downturns," he says. "Land values have not been overly affected."
